This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students achieving a 'C' standard or above in English across all classes from Prep to Year 10 Semester 2, 2017 to Semester 2, 2018 (see performance dashboard). Target: 85% of students achieving C or above.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving in the Upper Two Bands (U2B) from 24.42% to 30% in Reading.
- Improve relative gains in student achievement across Writing and Reading in NAPLAN Year 3, 2016 to Year 5, 2018, Year 5, 2016 to Year 7, 2018 and Year 7, 2016 to Year 9, 2018.

Monitoring measures:

- Student responses, for example, writing samples, summative tasks contained in assessment folios and performance on specific assessable elements contained in marking guides.
- Learning progressions/developmental maps, for example, P-10 Literacy Continuum, Bandscales State Schools.
- Early Start.
- Teacher-developed pre- and post-assessments.
- Teacher and/or teacher aide surveys, for example, evaluations of professional learning, self-efficacy surveys, classroom observations and student feedback.

Our initiatives include

- Developing and implementing a whole school approach to teaching writing.
- Embedding the culture, climate, processes and protocols of classroom observation and feedback to support professional development and encourage reflective practice/action learning.
- Using Early Start materials across Prep to Year 2 to inform teaching, learning and resourcing, and to track progress.
- Engaging the services of an experienced teacher/s or providing TRS to release a teacher to develop programs/materials to use in working with specific students on particular learning goals; and to provide professional development to staff in gradually shifting responsibility to students, monitoring techniques and extending students' thinking.
